We are elated that you are considering Bayside Clubs at Manatee Bay. Bayside Clubs is an Extended Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) available through the partnership of ASP and Manatee Bay Elementary.

We regard the development and implementation of extracurricular activities and clubs as a positive and meaningful contribution to the lives of our students. A child's education does not take place only in the classroom, during regular school hours. Hence, school sponsored afterschool activities can be an invaluable setting for a child's continued personal and academic growth. Bayside Clubs provide students with the following:

- Opportunities to develop socially through engaging activities which develop and strengthen character, leadership skills and social skills.
- Participation in multiple forms of co-curricular activities involving common interests of club members.

Days and Times of Club Meetings

Spring Session of Bayside Clubs will begin on Monday, March 27 and ends May 26, 2017. Clubs can meet on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays or Fridays between the hours of 2:00 – 3:15p.m. Drama meets every Friday from 2:00- 4:15. Please see the club description below for the specific day each club will meet.

Cost

Clubs that are eight week sessions are \$140 per child. The Performing Arts Club is \$630 and runs the entire year. There is a 10% discount for siblings. The clubs meet the weeks of March 27^h through the week of May 22th(eight weeks). Fees are due the day of registration. Please make your check payable to ASP. **CHECKS AND CREDIT CARDS are accepted.**

Arrival/Dismissal

Students will be dismissed to Bayside clubs beginning at 2:00p.m. on their club meeting days. At 2:00p.m., students will report to the cafeteria. Mrs. Vital and paraprofessionals will stay with the children until the club sponsor arrives at 2:30p.m.

Each club will have a check-in and check-out notebook. Upon the students' arrival, the paraprofessionals will take attendance and mark the students absent or present on the attendance sheets.

Students will be released only to adults listed on the student's *Bayside Clubs Registration Form*.

Students, who are not picked up at the end of club meeting sessions- 3:15p.m., must be picked up in the front office. Parents will be charged an additional \$25 fee if this occurs.

Afterschool Programs

Please note that Bayside Clubs are separate from ASP. Both programs have separate fees.

Parents who are not able to pick up their students from clubs by 3:15p.m. may pay for their child to be placed in ASP. ASP is available daily until 6:00p.m.
